M@LV March Meeting Notes – 2018

Next Meeting: Our next meeting will be on April 10 at 7:00 PM at Lehigh Valley Apple Store.

Dave Hinkel led our meeting. Before reviewing Adobe Premiere Elements 2018, he introduced us to two of his favorite programs he uses to download and removed clips from existing videos.

MPEG Streamclip Video Converter for Mac: MPEG Streamclip is a video converter, player and editor for MPEG and QuickTime. In addition it is a stream and YouTube downloader. It will cut, copy, paste, and trim videos and convert them to QuickTime, AVI, DV, or MPEG\$ files. It supports just about every video format. It is a free download.

Wondershare Video Converter: This free program will download YouTube videos and convert, edit and burn into any of 50 video or audio formats. After it downloads YouTube videos, it can trim, crop, rotate, and apply video effects, and then convert them for use on iPhone, iPad, iPod, and Apple TV for free. It supports all iOS devices.

Adobe Premiere Elements 2018: Premiere Elements is Adobe's movie editing program. Dave Hinkel introduced us to the capabilities of the newest version of Adobe's Premiere Elements and demonstrated how to create and edit a movie.

Premiere Elements has a strong organizational abilities and will produce visual catalogs of your videos. It will organize videos scattered among hundreds of folders on your computer. After organizing all of your videos, it will help you find what you are looking for.

Premiere Elements has guided edits for transitions, freeze frames, bounce-back effects, trimming, correcting exposure and distortion problems, creating titles, generating slow motion and fast motion effects, and creating special effects.

Premiere Elements intelligent edits allows extracting still photos, trimming out bad sections, removing haze, adding music, reducing shake, detecting faces, animating text, fine tuning sound, adjusting clip color, drag and drop editing, and balancing audio. It supports HD and 4K. It has tutorials to explain all of its capabilities.

Premiere Elements can enhance slide shows. It can create collages of photos and videos.

Premiere Elements will upload finished movies to YouTube, Facebook, Vimeo, or your own website. It will burn HD movies to DVD discs and share movies in 4K. It will export movies in formats for iPads, iPods, and smartphones and also to 4K and HD TVs. It will export in traditional 4:3 format or HD 16:9 format. It will create DVD menus wth themes, backgrounds, text and music.

Premiere Elements is often bundled with Adobe's Photoshop Elements, it's still image editor.

PrintShop for Mac 4: Harry showed us his new copy of PrintShop. It quickly and easily creates greeting cards, online greetings, banners, certificates, letterheads, envelopes, business cards, labels, signs, postcards, newsletters, booklets, pamphlets, CDs, calendars, and photo pages.

WillowLane WiFi: When the public Wi-Fi port doesn't work well, we can use the password protected port WillowLane which has the password: WillowLane2014.

TP-Link's KC120 Kasa Cam

TP-Link's KC120 Kasa Cam features a 1080p lens with a 130-degree field of view that should easily take in most good-sized living rooms. It sends push notifications when it detects motion and sound, and it supports two-way audio for communicating remotely with homebound family members (or creatively startling intruders).

Kasa has updated its subscription offering, now called Kasa Care, lowering some rates and adding an annual pricing option. The Basic plan is now simply called the Free plan. It gives you 1GB of storage and allows you view up to two days of video history for up to three cameras. The former Standard plan has been rechristened Plus and drops the price to \$4 a month

or \$40 per year per camera for 14GB and 14 days of video history. The Premium plan now costs \$7 a month or \$70 per year per camera for 30GB and 30 days of history. Each Kasa Cam purchase comes with a 30-day free trial of the Kasa Care Premium Plan.

The feed screen for the Kasa Cam is comparatively spartan—there’s only a large button labeled “enable talk” for triggering the mic and a calendar icon that takes you to the app’s scheduling feature. The mute button is the most notable omission, simply because hearing the feed’s ambient audio may not always be desirable depending on where you’re at when you’re checking in.

The Kasa Cam produced tack-sharp images in both 720p and 1080p resolution, with rich colors and even lighting. There wasn’t a trace of image-bending along the edges that you often see with wide-angle lenses, either. It retained that crispness in night vision mode, but the image lacked contrast, with darker colors all converting to the same middle grey tone. That made it hard to identify characteristics of people passing in front of the camera, particularly if they were at a distance as the Kasa Cam doesn’t have any zoom option. The Kasa Cam is a really impressive security camera with robust features you often don’t see at this price. The app is well designed and easy to use, and the camera’s integration with Echo Show makes it a great option for in-home monitoring if you have a baby or are caring for ailing elderly parents. Latest Mac Tips from Dave Mara:

iOS Tip: to display a grid in Camera that can help when composing a shot, go to Settings, tap Camera, then turn on Grid.

iOS Tip: to quickly view your passwords saved in iCloud Keychain, go to Settings, tap Accounts & Passwords, then tap App & Website Passwords.

iPad Tip: in iMovie, to start your movie with a fade-in, or end it with a fade-out, tap the Project Settings (gear) button, then tap to turn on "Fade in from black" or "Fade out to black".

iPad Tip: in Pages, to use Presenter Mode to scroll through your text automatically, like it's on a teleprompter, tap the More (⋮) button, then tap Presenter Mode.

iPhone Tip: in Control Center on iPhone with 3D Touch, touch and hold the Calculator control to quickly see the last results, then tap Copy Last Result to copy it.

iPhone Tip: on iPhone X, to quickly switch between apps, swipe right or left along the bottom edge of your screen.

App Store Tip: to automatically download apps that you purchased on a different Mac, choose App Store>Preferences, then select "Automatically download apps purchased on other Mac computers".

Calculator Tip: click the green zoom button to quickly switch from Basic to Scientific calculator view.

GarageBand Tip: to share a special GarageBand for iOS-compatible version of your GarageBand project, choose Share>Project to GarageBand for iOS.

GarageBand Tip: when recording using the metronome count-in, to set the number of bars for the count-in, choose Record>Count-in, then choose the number of bars from the submenu.

Keynote Tip: to add an interactive image gallery to a slide -- adding several images to the slide in one place, so only one shows at a time -- click the Media button in the toolbar, then choose Image Gallery.

Keynote Tip: to highlight selected text by adding a background color to it, click the Text tab in the Format sidebar, then click Style, then click the Advanced Options button in the Font section and choose a color for Text Background.

Mail Tip: on a Mac with a Force Touch trackpad, force click a package tracking number in a message to quickly see its shipping details.

Maps Tip: press Command-0 to quickly show or hide the 3D Map.

Maps Tip: to quickly show your current location, click the Current Location button in the toolbar, or press Command-L.

Messages Tip: to send a screenshot of a selected portion of your Mac's screen in a message, Control-click anywhere in the message field, then choose "Capture Selection from Screen" from the pop-up menu.

Numbers Tip: to add a donut chart to a spreadsheet, to visualize your data in an engaging new way, click the Chart button in the toolbar, then click 2D, then click the donut chart or drag it to the sheet.

Pages Tip: to have Pages check spelling while you type and correct mistakes automatically, choose Pages>Preferences, then click Auto-Correction and select "Correct spelling automatically".

Pages Tip: to set Pages to automatically format fractions as you type, choose Pages>Preferences, then click Auto-Correction and select the "Automatically format fractions" option.

Photos Tip: on a Mac with a Force Touch trackpad, when you arrow through photos in an Album or a Moment, apply additional pressure to your trackpad to go through them faster.

Photos Tip: to always show the sidebar and toolbar in full-screen view, choose View>Always Show Toolbar and Sidebar in Full Screen.

Photos Tip: to use Markup to write or draw on a photo, or to add shapes or a signature to it, double-click the photo, then click Edit in the toolbar, then click the Extensions (· · ·) button, then choose Markup.

Safari Tip: to sort your bookmarks, choose Bookmarks>Show Bookmarks, then Control-click the Bookmarks Menu folder in the sidebar and choose an option for Sort By.

Siri Tip: on a Mac, to show or hide Siri in the menu bar, open System Preferences, click Siri, then select or deselect "Show Siri in menu bar".

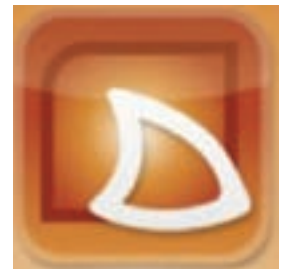
